

# Teacher Training

## Presentation

The presentation of a lesson is the culmination of the preparation.

### **PRAY**

Before any lesson is taught, the teacher should set some time aside to get alone with God and pray that the Holy Spirit would give the words to say and that God's Word would accomplish much in the lives of those who hear the teaching.

### **RECOGNIZE**

The teacher must recognize who the audience is and adjust the teaching style accordingly. It is also helpful to recognize the mood of the students and the class setting.

### **ENGAGE**

It is important that the teacher engages the students. Speak in a way that will catch their attention. Apply the lesson to the real life experiences of the students.

### **SPEAK CLEARLY**

It is difficult to follow and learn from a teacher that you cannot understand. Work on your speech. Practice the way you talk and work on pronouncing words correctly.

## **ENERGIZE**

The teacher must be enthusiastic when he or she teaches. If the teacher is not excited and passionate about the lesson then the students will not be excited. The teacher must energize the audience.

## **NETWORK**

Using various teaching aids is important in getting the message across. Everybody learns in different ways. Various visual aids and methods should be networked into every lesson.

## **TEACH**

Using various teaching methods is good. Learning to engage and energize the audience is good. However, the most important thing is that the material that is being taught is effectively communicated to the student. Do not get off track. Stay focused on the lesson at hand and teach what God has given you to teach.
